

Ph.D. Student Outreach

We are looking for a Ph-D student (ecology/silviculture) to start in fall quarter of 2010. The envisioned project utilizes data from the Density Management Study of western Oregon to investigate whether thinning practices, especially riparian buffer treatments, have an impact on moisture status of remaining trees, understory vegetation, and habitat suitability for amphibians. The study is likely to include field measurements, isotope analyses, and modeling efforts, including how the above described relationships vary with climate.

The position is covered by an assistantship, including tuition and health insurance.
